

EASTER MESSAGE (2019) TO THE NATION

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Beloved brethren

Dear Listeners / viewers

“Come receive the light from the never setting light! And glorify Christ who has risen from the dead”. Jn 1:4, 9. The Ekklesia is chanting the resurrection in Christ the Word of God, the incarnate and resurrected. Mt 22:31,32. For it is miracle unexplained, while it is the good news to all nations. The deity to come in humanity, in order mankind to return unto godliness! 2 Tim 1:10. Dan 12:2. Job 14:14. Therefore, let us chant for Him a new hymn, giving meaning to our life: “Christ is risen from the dead, trampling down Death by death, and upon those in the tomb bestowing life”! Gen 2:17. Pr 11:19. Is 25:8;53:12.

Our God loves us exceedingly. In Christ His Word He has revealed His will to us, not only in simple words as words, but also in actions of His Son and the Ekklesia, through the Holy Spirit.
